Sun City Stomperz celebrates 250 nights at Westbrook Village venue

The Sun City Stomperz, a 7-piece Traditional Dixieland Jazz band, was formed in 2005, and since then has performed their style of jazz at venues in the northwest valley. For 15 years the band has had a close relationship with the Lakes golf course restaurant in Westbrook Village. On the first night in 2010, the band was crammed onto part of the dance floor in the rear. The restaurant was then called Sunset Bistro at the Lakes; the management liked what they heard, and the band was moved up to the front of the room on a raised platform. From there until mid-2022, they performed twice a month to adoring audiences, for a total of 237 nights.

At that point there was a management change, and the name was changed to Charley's at the Lakes. The band was hired back for one night per month, and so it continues now, resulting in performance number 250 on Friday, September 12.
